


Discover the best of Tamil Nadu on a 9 night cultural journey through one of India's most colourful regions.

Day 1: UK - Chennai

Overnight flight from the UK to Chennai.

Day 2: Mahabalipuram

On arrival you will be met and transferred to your chosen hotel in Mahabalipuram.

Return to your hotel in the evening.

Day 4: Pondicherry

After breakfast, drive to Pondicherry, a charming coastal town with a few enduring pockets of French culture and an ashram.

Check in to your hotel and in the afternoon, explore nearby Auroville, Pondicherry Museum and the Botanical Gardens. The evening is free.

Day 5: Swamimalai

Depart for Swamimalai and visit Gangaikondacholapuram and Darasuram en-route.

On arrival, check into the resort and in the afternoon enjoy a tour of Tanjore.

Visit the most spectacular Brihadeeswara Temple, Saraswathi Mahal Library and Art Gallery with a large collection of Chola bronzes - a unique example of Hindu architecture.

Day 6: Swamimalai

Enjoy a day excursion to Trichy, visiting the Rock Fort and the Ganesh Temple built at its highest point.

Also visit the Tayumanaswamy and Srirangam temples.

Day 7: Chettinad


Depart for Chettinad and check in to your private bungalow for a 2 night stay.

Day 9: Madurai


Drive to Madurai in the morning and check in to your hotel.

In the evening, visit the Meenakshi Temple to attend the Pooja ceremony.


Day 10: Chennai

Discovery

Tamil Nadu (or 'Tamil Country') is the 6th most populous Indian State, famous for its Chola and Dravidian-style Hindu Temples, for historic and lively Chennai and for the Meenakshi Temple in Madurai.

Tamil Nadu's cultural legacy dates back two millenia and the vibrancy of Tamil culture can still be felt today. Art, literature and dance are one of the great living legacies of the Tamil civilisations.

The Dravidian-style Hindu Temples are perhaps the most famous feature of Tamil Nadu. Meenakshi Temple in Madurai is a wonderful place to people watch, whilst the shore temples of Mahabalipuram evoke a deep spirituality, especially at sunset.

The great Chola Empire temples at Tanjore are a highlight as are the sculptures and bronzes produced under the same empire.

Tamil cuisine is typically south Indian and there is a good opportunity during this trip to learn a bit more about it, as well as Tamil culture during a 2 night stay in Chettinad.


The tiny Union State of Pondicherry is included on this itinerary. Surrounded by Tamil Nadu it was founded as the HQ of the French East India Company.

October to February is generally considered the best time of year to visit the South Of India, with lower temperatures and generally settled weather. March to May sees higher temperatures and humidity. June to September is the main 'monsoon' season with higher rainfall, with the lighter North West monsoon continuing until December.

A visa is required for all UK passport holders travelling to India. These can be obtained easily via an online application. We can assist by providing details.


A holiday to the South of India can easily be combined with a stop in Dubai or an onward trip to Sri Lanka, the Maldives or other destinations in India.




Tamil Nadu has some of the most incredible temple architecture in the whole of India, and a vibrant music, dance and art culture.


